

His Name Is Jesus, He Is like No Other Lesson 6: Resurrected Like No Other

Matthew 28:1-10

Devotional Scripture: Psalms 95:1-6 NKJV

Oh come, let us sing to the LORD! Let us shout joyfully to the Rock of our salvation. Let us come before His presence with thanksgiving; Let us shout joyfully to Him with psalms. For the LORD is the great God, And the great King above all gods. In His hand are the deep places of the earth; The heights of the hills are His also. The sea is His, for He made it; And His hands formed the dry land. Oh come, let us worship and bow down; Let us kneel before the LORD our Maker.

Question: When were you excited to experience something firsthand?

Matthew 28:1-7

1 Now after the Sabbath, as the first day of the week began to dawn, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary came to see the tomb. 2 And behold, there was a great earthquake; for an angel of the Lord descended from heaven, and came and rolled back the stone from the door, and sat on it.

- **3** His countenance was like lightning, and his clothing as white as snow. **4** And the guards shook for fear of him, and became like dead men.
- **5** But the angel answered and said to the women, "Do not be afraid, for I know that you seek Jesus who was crucified. **6** "He is not here; for He is risen, as He said. Come, see the place where the Lord lay.
- **7** "And go quickly and tell His disciples that He is risen from the dead, and indeed He is going before you into Galilee; there you will see Him. Behold, I have told you.

Matthew 28:8-10

8 So they went out quickly from the tomb with fear and great joy, and ran to bring His disciples word. **9** And as they went to tell His disciples, behold, Jesus met them, saying, "Rejoice!" So they came and held Him by the feet and worshiped Him. **10** Then Jesus said to them, "Do not be afraid. Go and tell My brethren to go to Galilee, and there they will see Me."



Life Application Questions

- Why does it matter that Jesus physically rose from the dead?
- In what ways has Jesus resurrection impacted history?
- Why is worship still the appropriate response to the resurrection?
- How has Jesus' resurrection impact your life?

Live It Out

How should you respond to the hope of Jesus' resurrection?

- **Seek peace.** Too many people allow the fear of the future to hold them back. Ask the Holy Spirit to help you embrace the peace that comes with eternal life through Christ.
- **Celebrate!** Jesus' resurrection remains the best news anyone can hear. Therefore, make a concerted effort to celebrate that miracle.
- **Spread the Word.** Someone told you about the gift of eternal life available in Christ. Do the same for someone else by explaining how they can have a future hope in Christ.
